She is well known for her work on the sexualisation of children and her efforts to address violence against women. Melinda has published 5 books, and is a regular newspaper columnist and guest on Australian television. Her work is included in Steve Biddulph's parenting book "Raising Girls". A co-founder of Collective Shout: for a world free of sexploitation, Melinda is named in the Who's Who of Australian Women and the World Who's Who of Women.

Melinda is in great demand as a speaker internationally. She addresses thousands of young people each year in schools and youth events, parent groups, professional development courses, and international organisations.
